The Xavier's Resource Centre for the Visually Challenged (XRCVC), St. Xavier's College, Mumbai, is happy to announce its upcoming training programmes for visually challenged persons. There will be courses in Elementary Level English Language Training as well as Basic Computer Training & Introduction to Access Technologies.

- The Elementary English Training (EET) course will include training and practice sessions to develop listening, speaking, reading and writing skills as well as to expand vocabulary with emphasis on spelling and pronunciation along with grammar. This course begins on February 27, 2017 and will be held three days a week (Monday, Wednesday and Friday) (9.30 – 11.30 am and 2.00 – 4.00 pm) batches will flex according to the students requirements.
- The Basic Computer Training & Introduction to Access Technologies (BCT-AT) course will include training and practice sessions in accessible software including screen readers, screen magnifiers, OCR technology etc. This course begins on February 28, 2017 and will be held three days a week (Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday) 2.00 – 4.00 pm) batches will flex according to the students requirements.

Specific customisable needs will also be looked into. Teaching strategies will be worked around the learners' needs.
