We are happy to announce our first online workshop on the theme "**Using Speech to text apps for communication**" for persons with hearing impairment on 23rd September, 2023. This is because, 23rd September has been proclaimed by the UN as the International Day of Sign Languages. This Workshop is supported by the **Dhun Pestonji Parakh Discretionary Trust**.

There are situations wherein the persons with hearing impairment experience communication breakdown e.g., deaf student in a regular classroom attending to a verbal lecture or a deaf employee attending an online meeting.

Speech to text apps translate the speech to text form which deaf individuals will be able to read on their mobile phone as well as laptops. This will help to restore the communication breakdown.

In the upcoming workshop, we will know more about basic features of speech to text apps.
