Aim:

The aim of the workshop is to ensure that participants have enough skill and confidence to begin the process of inclusive practice within their respective school settings.

Level of Workshop: Level 1 (Basic)

(This is the first level; it will equip you with basic skills to handle students with blindness and low vision in class as also share expertise with co-colleagues once back.)

Language / Medium: English

(NOTE: A similar training workshop will be planned for non-English speaking participants at a later date. Hence, participants interested in the next workshop may apply after the announcement for the same.)

Content:

The workshop will equip you with:

- Basic understanding on approaches to teaching blind and low vision students
- Basic level knowledge and skill in the use of assistive aids and equipment (technology and non-technology)
- Knowledge and hands-on learning of various methods and techniques that can be employed in an inclusive classroom
- Awareness on other important tips and strategies

Methodology:

Simulations, Group Discussions, Presentations, Lesson Plan workshops will together be used to deliver the content.
