Google has removed basic HTML view from beginning 2024, Several users are getting puzzled to use the standard view, but this view provides an interface like that of other Google Workspace programs. It also offers various exciting features which can be functional using keyboard commands stated by either Google or screen reader.

In the upcoming workshop, we will explore and learn usable exciting features of G-Mail in standard view with screen reader NVDA.

Eligibility: participants should have a good knowledge of Internet browsing, typing and screen reader. Limited seats are available for the session.
