RoboBraille is an email- and web-based service designed to automatically convert documents into a wide range of accessible formats for persons with visual and reading impairments. Using this service, users can transform files into formats such as Audio, EPUB, DAISY Talking Books, Braille and many more.

This awareness workshop will provide participants with an introduction to the RoboBraille platform and demonstrate how to use the service effectively with the NVDA screen reader.
