The Dolphin EasyReader App removes barriers to accessible reading. With global links to libraries, it enables anyone with a print disability to read independently. It allows to connect with over 45 accessible libraries and newspaper services. EasyReader reads the widest range of book and document formats. including DAISY 2, DAISY 3, ePub, MathML, Microsoft Word documents, HTML and text files.
