Do you sometimes miss out on understanding the finer visual elements of concepts you are exposed to? The difference between a tortoise and a turtle, for example.

XRCVC's Visual Concept Enrichment (VCE) sessions attempt to bridge this gap!

These sessions will be conducted based on your interests to help you enhance your understanding of visual concepts – things that you may have studied about or heard your family and friends discussing. You perhaps may have the theoretical knowledge of the same, but you may not know how these things look. The XRCVC would like to try and explain these concepts using **tactile aids** that will allow you to visualize these concepts while having conversations with those who are sighted.

Even though we will have discussions around the topic for the day, these will definitely not be in a lecture-based format. We shall use models and tactile diagrams resourced and housed by the centre.

For whom?

High school or college students with blindness or low vision.

The maximum capacity per batch is 6 students. Once you register, you must be available and meet the terms listed below.
